Background Information

- The Agreement with Providence Teachers Union Local 958 and the City of Providence contained a no layoff clause.
- This no layoff clause removed the option for the School Board to balance future budgets by laying off teachers.
- The result of this clause was a new pool of displaced teachers.

Number of Displaced Teachers

- 1. The School Department was unable to provide actual year end number of displaced teachers. This estimate is based on a list provided by The School Department in September 2011.
- 2. The School Department provided this number. Number does not include 1 displaced teacher on WC, 2 displaced teachers that retired or 1 displaced teacher on leave with no pay or benefits.
- 3. Number provided by school department.

Cost Comparison Assumptions

- The average total cost per displaced teacher in 2012-2013 was \$94,122. This total average cost was used for the 2011-2012 school year to estimate total cost.
- The total annual cost for a non-certified \$100 per diem substitute is \$19,377 which includes FICA.
- The total annual cost for a \$150 LTSP is \$33,608 which includes FICA and single health coverage.
