

## School Classification Criteria

### Commended Schools

Defined by the following criterion:

- Total points greater than or equal to 77

### Leading Schools

Defined by the following criterion:

- Total points greater than or equal to 70 but less than 77

### Typical Schools

Defined by the following criterion:

- Total points greater than or equal to 50 but less than 70

### Warning Schools

Defined by any of the following criteria:

1. Total points less than 50
2. School wide participation rate less than 95%
3. Percent proficient points less than or equal to 10
4. Subgroup gap points less than 15
5. Student growth points less than or equal to 7.5
6. Sum of graduation rate and high school scaled score points less than or equal to 10
7. Failure to attain any AMO for two consecutive years
8. Failing graduation rate over time

### Focus Schools

Defined by either of the following criteria:

1. Subgroup gaps points less than 12
2. Percent proficient points less than 10

### Priority Schools

Defined by either of the following criteria:

1. Among the 8 schools with the lowest total points (i.e. < 37.8)
2. All current PLA schools that are receiving SIG funds
