TRANSPORTATION UPDATE

Consultant's Review - Background

- PPSD asked MPS, Inc, the consultants who did the review of the transportation operation this past school year, to conduct a follow-up study.
- MPS was on site from September 30, 2013 to October 2, 2013.
- Findings were issued on October 25, 2013.

Summary of Findings

- The consultants determined:
 - Our bus fill rates improved from 70% to 77%.
 - Our average run time is down 1 minute from last year.
 - We have almost no buffer time built into the system; in particular, we are severely constrained in the 3:15 p.m. to 3:45 p.m. region, resulting in many late busses for the 3:31 p.m. dismissal schools.

Summary of Findings, cont.

- While the bell times were changed, the time between them was not increased as originally recommended.
- There is not enough time between tiers.
- Bus routes were not re-engineered. While their original recommendation was not to re-engineer the bus routes if possible, they were also very specific that re-engineering was necessary if the bell times were changed.

Conclusions

- The consultant advised us that we were running a very constrained system that would respond negatively to virtually any disruption.
 - A small snow storm, an accident, or even unusually heavy traffic could severely affect our ability to transport our students in a timely manner.
- We need to:
 - Re-engineer Routes
 - Add a limited number of buses.

The consultants have advised that the industry standard for late busses is 2%.

Actions Taken / Planned

- Transportation Management Reassigned
- Edulog routing specialist with 17 years experience brought in to re-engineer the routes and add buses as necessary.
 - Routing is a six-week process during the summer, when the busses aren't moving.
 - We are rerouting now while the busses are moving; we expect to be done by Thanksgiving.



Changes...So Far

- Moved 56 buses to earlier departure times.
- Rerouted the Hopkins buses.
 - Added 1 bus
 - Changes started 11/13/2013.
- Rerouted the Greene buses.
 - Added 1 bus
 - Changes started 11/18/2013.
- Rerouting to Stuart and Williams done.
 - Added no buses.
 - Changes start November 25, 2013.
- These changes solve many of the 2nd tier problems, as well.

Changes....to Come

- Delsesto
- Fortes/Lima
- Kennedy
- Bishop
- Lauro

These changes should be accomplished by Thanksgiving.

Data

- Late arrivals are approaching 2% in the morning and late busses in the afternoon are improving.
